Senior Staff Engineer Bergman updated the board on the status of the Stoneray Wind project. A meeting will be held on April 12th at 10:00 a.m. at the Highway Department meeting room with representatives from EDF Renewables, Pipestone and Murray County officials, Rock, Burke and Aetna Township board members to provide a progress update on project set to start on May 21, 2018.

Senior Staff Engineer Bergman presented an update from the March 7, 2018 Road and Bridge Public Hearing.

- 1. County road 6 and 8 in the Holland area will be checked for possible overlay project in the 5-year plan.
- CSAH 17 will have core samples taken to check on status of the gravel and also the crown will be checked. Commissioner Kooiman asked for possible inclusion of the road on the 5-year Road and Bridge plan.
- 3. Second year of dust control plan program is underway. Last year 3 landowners on CSAH 17 took advantage of the cost share plan. Staff Engineer Bergman will obtain quotes for calcium chloride for the 2018 year. Commissioners also requested the possibility of adding CSAH 25 from Trunk Highway 23 to the intersection of Trunk Highway 30 near Pipestone County Implement for dust control treatment.

Senior Staff Engineer Bergman provided board members with Highway Department Maintenance updates. He reported that crews were out 9 days in March plowing and sanding roads. Road posting signs were installed on March 9, 2018. Several culverts froze up causing flooding and road washouts requiring repair, one mile of road was closed due to runoff flooding. He also reported that the new Caterpillar grader was delivered on March 15th and was being readied for service. That grader will be housed in the Ruthton shop.

Chairman Wildermuth requested that Engineer Dave Halbersma come to the podium so that he could be thanked by the Commissioners for his 33 years of service with Pipestone County and wished him well in his retirement.
