### **BUFFALO RIDGE DRUG TASKFORCE PRESENTATION**

Chief Deputy Mike Hamann, and Lieutenant Edison Dengler appeared to present a PowerPoint presentation on the activities of the Buffalo Ridge Drug Taskforce. Also present was Buffalo Ridge Drug Taskforce Leader Chris Lewis from Murray County. Slides included information of numbers of arrests, quantities of drugs confiscated, hazards of drug use and educational slides on different types of illegal drugs. Commissioners thanked them for their very informative presentation.

### **LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES MEAL PROGRAM**

Sarah Anderson, Regional Program Manager from Lutheran Social Services Meal Program appeared to present information on their program in Pipestone County and the region. She reported that over 14,000 meals are served in Pipestone County annually and that there is a need for more people and groups to become involved with delivering meals on wheels and support from the community with their time and also financial donations to help the program continue. Commissioners thanked Ms. Anderson for the information.

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**FAIRGROUNDS CONCRETE FLAT WORK PROJECT**

Building and Maintenance Supervisor Wayne Drew appeared to present quotes for concrete work at the Quonset Building on the South end of the fairgrounds. Tim Rustad Construction, Pipestone, Mn. \$4,620.00, Martinez Concrete LLC, Jasper Mn. \$4,000.00. Motion by Kooiman, seconded by Nath to approve the quote from Martinez Concrete, LLC for removal of 20' by 19' of old concrete and replace with new 6" with rebar and construct a new exterior approach with 6" concrete and rebar and 13' by 5" of sidewalk with 4" concrete and rebar. **PAY REQUEST #6 CENTRAL SCHOOL DEMOLITION**
