- · You will be asked for your name, address, phone number and nature of your visit.
- Visits to multiple Courthouse Offices will require separate appointments.
- If you have any symptoms of COVID-19, cough, fever, shortness of breath, muscle aches, or sore throat we ask that you not schedule an appointment. If you have been exposed to, or been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results, we ask that you do not schedule an appointment at this time.
- If in between the time of your call and your appointment time, you develop any of the symptoms listed above please call and cancel.
- · Visitors with appointments at the Courthouse will be met at the East Annex Entrance by an office employee and escorted to the office. Only the visitor with the appointment will be admitted. If an interpreter or personal assistant is required they will be admitted with the appointment holder.
- · Masks are to be worn by visitors to county offices. If you don't have a mask, a face cloth covering such as a bandana or scarf may be used.
- Once the appointment is concluded you will be escorted out of the building by an employee.
